Dear parents and carers,

I would like to share with you all the exciting plans we have for you and the children in the lead up to Christmas. This is a long letter, but we wanted to make sure that you had as much of the information as possible about our exciting half term!

Tuesday 10th December - The choir have been invited to entertain a local friendship group. Sergeant Peppers Friendship club are situated in Wall Heath community centre, and they work hard to combat loneliness and isolation which can arise within the elderly. They are a group of around 80 regular visitors and their friends. They meet once a week to share new experiences, have a coffee and a catch up. We are now regulars at this event, after performing for them in October and last Christmas. For this, children in the choir can wear a festive jumper or something to add to their uniform to add to the carol celebration. We will be walking from school to the community centre and will return before lunch.

Tuesday 10th December - We would love our Reception and KS1 parents to join us for a Christmas workshop in school! At 1.30pm-3.15pm. Adults will be able to enter their child's classroom in Reception and Year 1 from the playground. Year 2 adults can enter from the main office and will be shown to the Year 2 classroom. (If you have 2 or more children in Reception/KS1 please go to your youngest child's classroom and we can send your older sibling to you). There will be a carousel of 4 activities over the afternoon, and you can have a go at each Christmas activity with your child. This will then finish at 3.15pm. There will be lots of arts and crafts to get us all into the Christmas spirit! We will be asking for an indication of numbers via a form on School Life over the next few weeks, this will be 1 adult per child due to limits on space in classrooms.

Wednesday 11th December - Choir (Year 2 and up because of numbers and limited space) will be going to a local care home with our anti-bullying ambassadors as part of their community work. During the morning, they will be sharing Christmas carols with residents and making Christmas cards.

Friday 13th December - This will be our Christmas Disco for all the children, organised by our brilliant HSA! 4.15pm-5.15pm for Rec/KS1 and 5.30-6.30pm for KS2. Tickets will be on the school shop to be purchased.

Tuesday 17th December and Wednesday 18th December - The children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be performing their Nativity play for their adults 'Don't be Afraid' on Tuesday 17th at 9.30am and 2pm and Wednesday 18th at 2pm at school. Tickets will cost £1, and each child will be allocated 3 tickets, these will be on the school shop to be purchased. These can be spread over the 3 performances or all 3 in one performance, but it must be 3 tickets in total per child to allow us to have every child celebrated by their grown-ups. We can only have 100 adults at each performance, due to fire regulations, so it will be first come first serve for allocation. **Thursday 19th December** - Christmas dinner day and Christmas jumper day. Children can wear a Christmas jumper instead of their school jumper for the day, over their uniform and donate to Save the Children.

Friday 20th December - KS2 Carols on the playground. We will be inviting adults along to our KS2 Christmas Carol Concert on the KS2 playground at 2.30pm. You will be able to enter the KS2 playground via the Maidensbridge gate from 2.25pm. After we have enjoyed hearing Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 singing their Christmas songs we will be offering hot chocolate and mince pies in your child's classroom if your child is in Year 3 and 4. And in the hall, if your child is in Year 5 and 6.

Friday 20th December - our last day of the term and is a normal finish time of 3.15pm. The children will be having parties in their classrooms on this day and can come to school in their party clothes. We will also have our end of term House Event for the winning house, this will be a special Christmas treat for the winning team!

Children will then be back in school on Monday 6th January 2025 at 8.35am.

It is lovely to have all these things planned for our children and families to enjoy. Watch out for forms to complete and tickets etc on School Life for these events so that they can all go smoothly, and we can have a fantastic lead up to Christmas.
